



Weathervane Playhouse In-person Camp Policies and Procedures 2021

Our number one priority is to create a safe, clean, and healthy space for students to take part in camps. Please review the policies and procedures below before registering for an in-person camp.

How are we keeping campers safe?

- Mask requirements for teachers and students
- Limited number of camps and campers
- Temperature checks
- Hand sanitizing stations
- Outdoor play (when possible)
- Social distancing

General Policies:

- Mask Requirements for teachers and students
 - All students must wear a mask unless eating or otherwise told by their instructor.
 - If a student shows up to camp without a mask, one can be provided for them.
 - If your student cannot wear a mask, we can recommend an online program that would best suit them
- All students must arrive no earlier than 15 minutes to check-in for camp.
- Camp Capacity
 - There will only be one in-person camp in one space at a time.
 - Each camp will max out at 12 students, unless the space is able to accommodate more with social distancing 6 feet apart.

If a student is not observing Weathervane's Policies and Procedures, their parent/guardian will be notified. If the problem is not rectified, they will be asked to leave for the remainder of the program without a refund.

Procedures:

Drop off & Check-in

- Check-in will begin 15 minutes before the camp begins. We ask that students arrive to check-in at this time.
- We encourage that only members of the students' household should drop-off and pick-up when possible.
- Students will enter through the front door by themselves. Parents can pull up in-front of the door to drop their student off.
- The lobby will not be open for parents, guardians, or others not participating in the camp.
- A Staff member will be there to take the students' temperature, make sure they sanitize their hands, check them in, and show them where to sit.

During Camp

- Once in the camp, students will sit in their assigned square where they will keep their personal items (coat, water, lunch, etc.)
 - The squares will be spaced out in such a way that social distancing can be observed
- Some activities will be done outdoors (weather pending)
- Throughout the camp, students will be given water and sanitizing breaks.
- Students will be instructed to keep distance from others during activities.
 - If this becomes an issue parents will be contacted. If the issue does not resolve itself, the student will not be allowed back to camp.

Camp Pick-up

- Once the camp is over, students will wait in their assigned areas and gather all of their items.
- When parents/guardians arrive they will park in the parking lot.
- The staff member will walk/direct each student one at a time to their designated car.
